## FOR DOGS



Never leave dogs in parked cars — even with windows cracked.



Avoid midday walks: hot pavement can burn paws.



Keep fresh, cool water available at all times.



Know the signs of heatstroke: heavy panting, glazed eyes, rapid heartbeat.





Provide cool, shaded outdoor shelters for cats that roam.



Be mindful of **toxic summer plants** (e.g., lilies, azaleas).



**Store chemicals** like pesticides or lawn treatments safely.



Watch for **bug bites or ticks** — check fur regularly.
